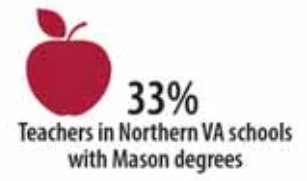

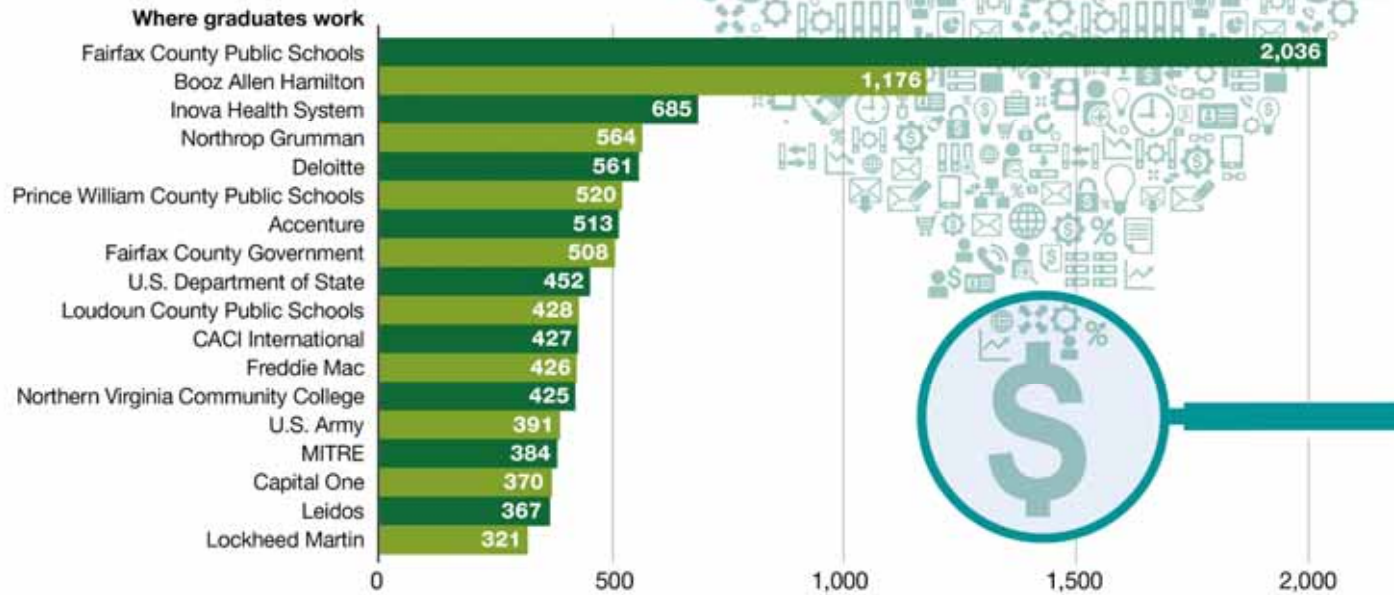

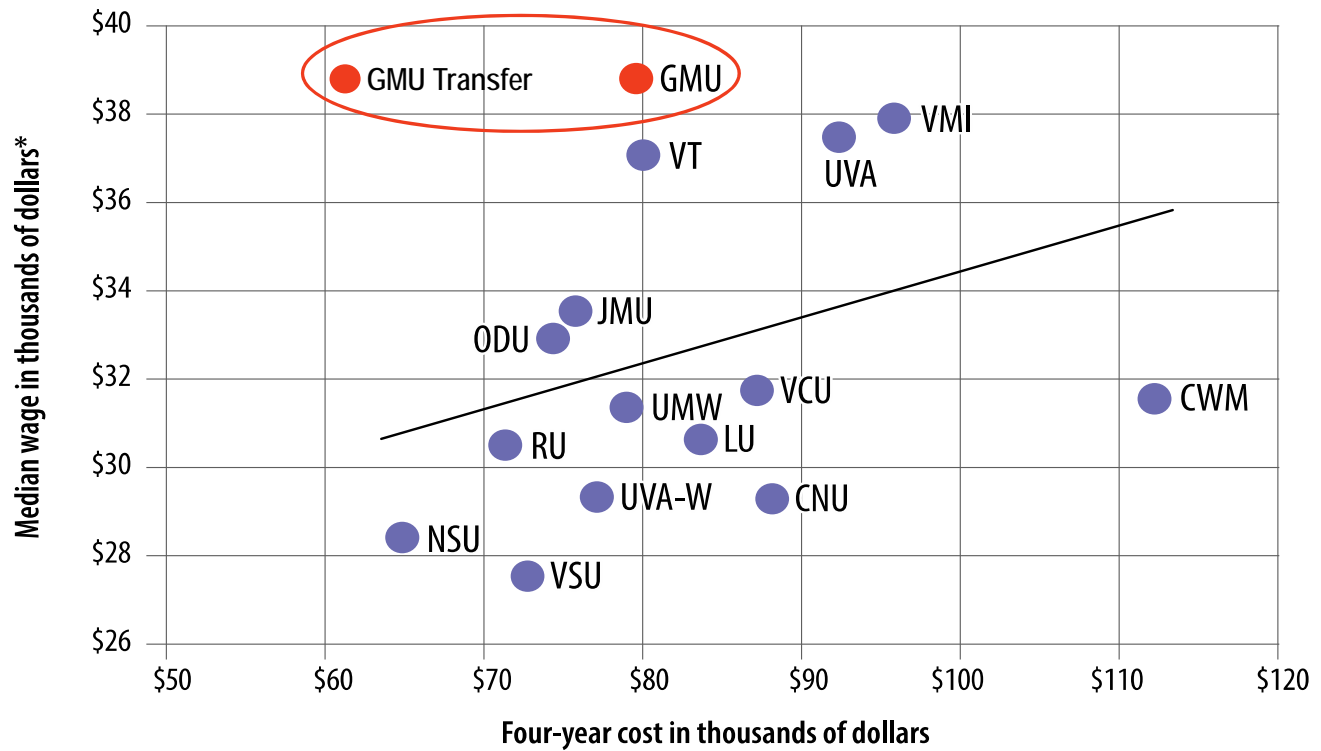
- 2017 Bachelor's Graduates: **25%** are in STEM fields
