

Mason SBDC and PTAP established 1987 Mentor Protégé Program 1994 MEC-Fairfax incubator opened; SBDC, PTAP and MPP co-located Community Business Partnership (CBP), 501c3 established: SBDC and Business Finance Center Women's Business Center (WBC) at CBP established 2000 Virginia SBDC Network moved to Mason **MEC-Leesburg** opened 2011 MEC-Fauquier opened 2014 2015 Veterans Business Outreach Center (VBOC) at CBP established 2017 Innovation Commercialization Assistance Program (ICAP) revamped 2018 Mentor Protégé Program shut down


