University Fast Facts

- George Mason is the largest public research university in Virginia with **40,449** students from all 50 states and 130 countries.
- George Mason produces more tech graduates than any other four-year institution in Virginia.
- George Mason's entrepreneur and small business programs have had an estimated economic impact in Virginia of more than **\$1.6 billion**.
- **1,227** Mason students and **7,307** alumni reside in Arlington County.

Arlington County Impact

Business

- **Small Business Development Centers** – Mason provides free business counseling and training services to small businesses in Arlington. In 2024, the Mason SBDC provided services to 213 Arlington County business owners and entrepreneurs. Mason SBDC helped to create 8 businesses and 34 jobs, while retaining 104 jobs in the county.
- **Mason Virginia Promise** - The Mason Virginia Promise is a guaranteed pathway to a bachelor's degree or help to start a business for every Virginian who wants one.

Education

- **Early Identification Program (EIP)** - With over 2,000 graduates, EIP provides access to educational resources for middle and high school students who will be the first in their families to attend a college or university.
- **ADVANCE** - Partnership with Northern Virginia Community College to increase graduation rates among transfer students and smooth the path to a degree while students saving time and money.

Community

- **Mason Veterans & Servicemembers Law Clinic** – Antonin Scalia Law School students provide pro-bono legal assistance to Veterans, active duty service members, and their families.
- **Conflict Resolution Counseling** - Faculty from The Jimmy and Rosalynn Carter School for Peace and Conflict Resolution partners with organizations to address issues related to anti-racism and inclusiveness in the Arlington Community.

Technology

- **Commonwealth Cyber Initiative (CCI)** – The Northern Virginia Node of the CCI is headquartered in the Innovation Pilot Space. CCI is Virginia's main access point for cybersecurity research, innovation, workforce development, and news.
