Fast Facts

- George Mason is the largest public research university in Virginia with **40,449** students from all 50 states and 130 countries.
- George Mason produces more tech graduates than any other four-year institution in Virginia.
- George Mason's entrepreneur and small business programs have had an estimated economic impact in Virginia of more than **\$1.6 billion**.
- Approximately **10,514** Mason students and **60,905** alumni reside in Fairfax County.

Fairfax County Engagement

Education

- **ADVANCE** Partnership with NOVA Community College to increase graduation rates among transfer students.
- **Early Identification Program** Partnership with local public schools to prepare first-generation students for college. There are **339** Fairfax County Public School students participating in EIP.
- **Dream Catchers** Mentorship program utilizing the George Mason community to support students enrolled in Fairfax County Public Schools' Nontraditional School Programs.
- **Environmental Research and Education** Over **40,000** K-12 students have received environmental instruction at the Potomac Science Center since 2009.

Business

- Small Business Development Centers (SBDCs) In 2024, 1,395 businesses located in Fairfax County were served by Mason SBDCs. Thirty-three (33) new businesses were established with assistance from Mason SBDC. The centers helped to create 246 new jobs and retain 472 jobs.
- **Mason Virginia Promise** George Mason provides a guaranteed pathway to a bachelor's degree or help to start a business.

Health

- **MAP Clinics** Over **5,000** unique patients received FREE healthcare, school physicals, screenings, and mental health services.
- **Center for Community and Mental Health** Provides evidence-based, accessible, affordable and culturally sensitive thearpy and testing services.

- **Camps & Youth Programs** George Mason hosts a variety of camps and youth programs with a wide array of topics and themes.

Community Assets

- **Center for the Arts** The Center for the Arts is the heart of performing arts on George Mason's Fairfax Campus. The center showcases national and international artists.
